Salmon are a cultural icon and economic resource of the Pacific Northwest, but in recent years their numbers have dwindled.

In an effort to restore populations, environmental groups and tribal, commercial and recreational fishing interests have called for the removal of four dams in Eastern Washington State, on the lower Snake River. But rural communities dependent on the dams have greeted this idea with considerable skepticism. The resulting controversy reaches to the heart of the ideological differences that divide the Northwest.

Through interviews and careful observation, River Ways examines the ordinary lives of a fascinating set of characters affected by this profoundly complex issue.
